Traditional land acknowledgement UNB

We respectfully acknowledge that UNB stands on the unsurrendered and unceded traditional Wolastoqey (WOOL-US-TOOK-WAY) land.

The lands of Wabanaki (WAH-BAH-NAH-KEE) people are recognized in a series of Peace and Friendship Treaties to establish an ongoing relationship of peace, friendship and mutual respect between equal nations.

The river that connects our two campuses is known as Wolastoq (WOOL-LUSS-TOOK), along which live Wolastoqiyik (WOOL-US-TOO-GWEEG) – the people of the beautiful and bountiful river. Wolastoq (WOOL-LUSS-TOOK) is also called the St. John River.

• Renewed Tuition Bursary (RTB) (max of \$3,000.00) will be the second tier of support after CSG-D has been calculated and RTB will cover the remaining costs of tuition (up to the maximum of \$3,000.00) for families whose gross income is \$60,000.00 or less. It employs a sliding scale which gradually reduces the benefit to students from families with incomes greater than \$60,000, up to the maximum income cut-off.

• <u>IF eligible</u>, CSG D and/or CSG for Dependents will follow RTB support in the funding tier.

MAINTAINING THE TEMPORARY COVID BENEFIT:

The \$96/mo for student living with parents; \$205 for student not living with parents.

THRESHOLDS FOR PARENTAL OR SPOUSAL CONTRIBUTION REDUCED:

As of 2022-2023, there will be an increase in the threshold at which parental income is considered to grant loans and bursaries from \$55,000 to \$75,000 for parents living together, from \$50,000 \$65,000 for a single parent and \$48,000 to \$63,000 for a spouse. Also, the threshold for exemption of income from child support considered in aid

CONTINUATION OF THE ELIMINATION OF INTEREST ON STUDENT LOANS FOR 2022-2023: To ease the burden of student debt, the government will continue to bear the interest that should have been paid on student loans between April 1, 2022 and March 31, 2023 **THE CREATION OF A NEW FORM:** 1073 Request a Review to include when submitting an appeal of decisions rendered on student's file


UAlberta Campus Map Through Indigenous Eyes:

Alberta Student Aid- Updates/Changes

- Policy:
 - Student loan and updated policy for 2022/2023 will be released the week of June
 20
 - Keep an eye on the OOP summary for updates at that time
- My Alberta Digital ID (MADI):
 - As of September 8 students will be required to sign up for a verified My Alberta Digital ID (MADI) account to access the loan application.
 - Students will need a piece of provincial ID with correct address in order to have their account verified. More info <u>here</u>.
 - Students who apply before Sept. 8 will still be able to access the loan app, but will need to update their account after.



Alberta Student Aid- Updates/Changes

Application changes:

- Students will be able to log in to their Alberta Student Aid account and amend their application dates or cancel their applications. This means, when the student has not selected the correct dates AND their registration has already been confirmed, you may reach out to them to have them change their dates.
- If funds have been paid, the student must submit a Request for Review.

Request For Review: 2022/2023 Full-Time Post-Secondary Studies 01-Jan-2023 to 30-Apr-2023 STATUS: Under Review - Your Level 1: Request for Reconsideration is currently under review. It may take up to 30 days to process your application. CANCEL CANCEL *Lancel Lancel Lancel*

- <u>ASA Contact Centre</u>, but staff should contact the Client Resolution Unit (CRU) if you have inquiries: <u>cru@gov.ab.ca</u> (this is for school use only. Do not give to students).
 - Contacting CRU may save the student from needing to do things such as appeal (or Request for Review- RFR). If in doubt, send along an email!
- Schedule 4 submissions (for disability) are currently very backlogged. With this and MADI changes happening- best to tell students to apply early!
