- ▶ *Canada began using currency in 1867 & the first residential school was opened in 1880. Last residential school closed in 1997.*
- ▶ *We were a people who lived off the land, we were part of the eco-system.*
- ▶ *Money and material items did not make us rich; Kindness and generosity was what gave us a sense of wealth*
- ▶ *We only used what we needed and made use of everything our environment provided for us.*
- ▶ *There were no efforts made by the government to sustain us economically.*
- ▶ *Today we have the resources to empower ourselves today for our children tomorrow.*

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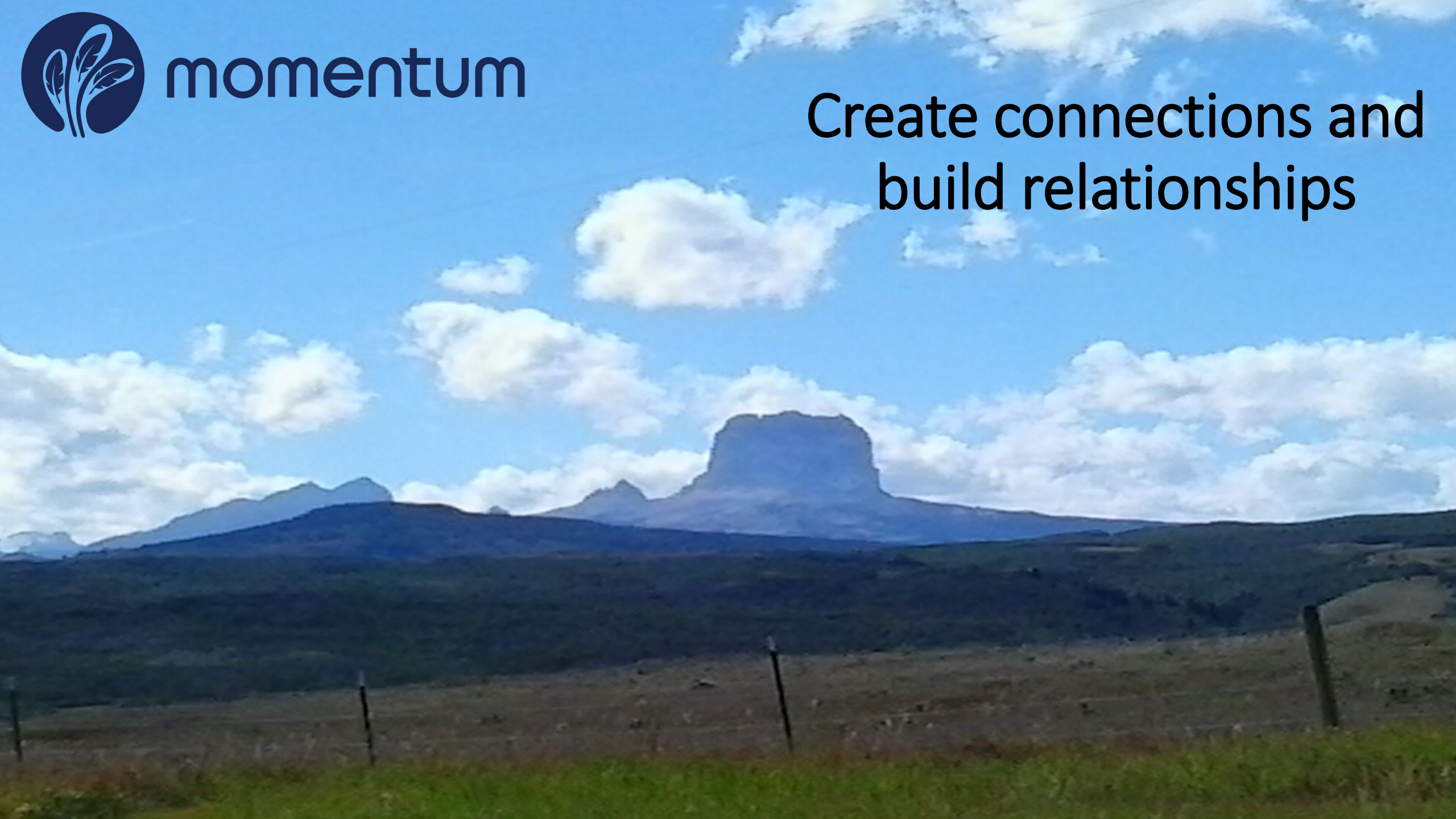

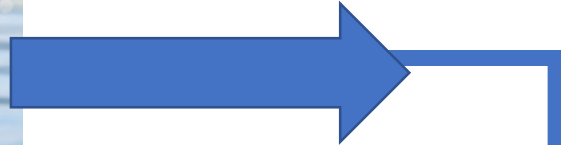


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
