Policies

Academic: Those with study permits approved before March 18 '20 allowed to come to Canada; eligibility for post-graduate work-permit intact for existing and new students—online & from outside of Canada

Financial: Working permitted even with reduced studies (>20 hours in essential jobs), CERB eligibility & CESB's support for domestic students freed up additional support for international students

Immigration: April 2021, IRCC's PR status grant

RESULT: Internationally, Canada is viewed as welcoming, supportive and safe. We're student-friendly with clear paths to citizenship.






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






